Additional information discussed at the meeting:

Each round costs \$75 which includes Greens Fees and lunch

Tournament Chair: Regarding the budget, Amanda pointed out that there are three budgeted events: OLGA Cup, Club Championship, and the Summer Tournament. The self-sustaining events are: Traveling Teams expenses, Member/Guest, PICO, and Kings & Queens.

Handicap Chair: There have been several new members.

Pairings Chair: Starting in May, league will have shotgun tee times starting at 8:00 am and 11:30 am.

Rules Chair: Karen reported that it has been seen where some members are "sweeping" their ball into the hole. They MUST strike the ball into the hole. The rule has been posted on the OLGA site.
